

FOSTER CARE IN INDIA

Around the world, there are lots of children begging for money on the streets – abandoned, orphaned, surrendered, and even ill treated by their own parents. Adoption, pre-adoption care, and foster care agencies are life-saving strategies for these unfortunate children, or should I say these fortunate ones who get adopted by these beautiful hearts? There are three main organizations that play a vital part in planning child care in India:

- DCPU – District Child Protective Unit
- CARA/CARINGS – Central Adoption Resource Authority
- CWC – Child Welfare Committee

Pre-foster care is where adoption is already in progress by prospective parents. A child is taken in by prospective parents before permanent adoption of the child. Once the parents are accepted by the adoption committee, within 10 days, the child is sent to live with the parents. In the meantime, the adoption committee submits a petition to the court's approval. Parents study and understand the child and, if there are compatibility issues or any other concern, they are provided counseling. If counseling doesn't work, the child is sent back to the adoption agency and is considered legally free (is up for adoption again). The petition is withdrawn from court.

Foster care/alternate care facilities are a marvelous concept to give a child a normal family environment before getting adopted. It is in its infancy in India and strategies are continuously being worked on to efficiently build a strong foster care framework. In India, the history of foster care can be traced back to 1960. The first non-institutional scheme was introduced in Maharashtra in 1972. Foster care finally came into light in the recent years and Foster Care India is one of the first organizations formed in Udaipur, Rajasthan. A child is put into foster care after getting an order from the CWC. The foster parents are chosen, approved, and supervised by the DCPU. The DCPU acts as a Nodal authority and CWC decides foster care placements. Periodic checks are done and reports are collected to check compatibility and conditions in the foster house. An individual child care plan is developed for a child and monetary arrangements are complete.

Once the child turns 18, they are free to move out of the foster house and are considered legally free. A foster house can have only eight children in total, including biological children of the parents, if any. A short term foster care is less than a year and a longer term is when it goes beyond a year. Foster kids are allowed to meet their biological parents to have that bond.

Can foster parents be permanent parents?

YES! If the foster parents have been taking care of the child/children for five years and choose to adopt them, they are given priority over other applicants. Foster care can also be considered as a backdoor entry to adoption. Adoption is always given priority over foster care. Children are approved for foster care for two reasons:

- Children are not declared legally free for adoption.
- Children are legally free, but cannot be taken for adoption for a short period.

India's foster care system is evolving and the future can expect a happy and successful foster future.

Significance of Foster Care

As we enter May, the National Foster Care Month, let's all make a difference to last a lifetime! "Every child dreams of a family, so is every soul longing for love." Why wait? Foster a child, Foster a future. Foster Care is a 24-hour home-like atmosphere in which a minor child who cannot be with his or her parents for some reason is provided a safe and stable environment. The place can be a ward, group home, or private home under the responsibility of a state-certified foster parent. This placement is usually done either by the government or a social service agency. Benefits of this system are multifold. Children remain in a home-like or family setting along with their siblings (if any), attend community schools, experience family holidays and events, form social relationships, and gain individualized attention. Foster Care is a nurturing temporary support, NOT a substitute for parents.

How it works?

In many cases, foster care acts as a forever home. The end goal for foster parents is to encourage family reunification. This means that the biological parents can take time to resolve their struggles and get their lives back on track for the sake of their children. Unlike adoption, there are no restrictions for parents and children to meet each other.

Here are few statistics about foster care:

- Children are due to negligence, substance abuse and inability to cope up.
- Majority of children are from White, African American, and Hispanic ethnicities.
- 40% of the children go to only 1 foster care support environment.

- 45% of children are supported by non-relatives, followed by 30% of relatives.
- Youth who leave foster care become homeless for the next 1-2 years.
- 60% of girls become pregnant within a few years of leaving.

Children and teens in foster care need YOU! Yes, you can change a life. Criteria to become a Foster Parent:

- ✓ Must be at least 21 years of age (any gender, or marital status)
- ✓ No criminal background
- ✓ Must be employed or steady monthly income
- ✓ Have a home (own or rental) meeting the licensing requirements
- ✓ Have a home study completed
- ✓ Exhibit emotional stability, physical health, reasonable discipline, and supervising ability.

If you are approved, you will receive training and payments to help you meet the daily needs of the child or children placed in your care along with medical coverage.

Instant Family uses Humor and Heart to Portray Foster Care Adoption

Inspired by a true story of the film's director and writer, Sean Anders, and his wife, Beth, *Instant Family* depicts the story of a couple who adopt three siblings out of the foster care system. *Instant Family* is a heartwarming, emotionally feel good comedy film that, delivered with the laughs, has a heart to the story and characters (IMDb). Released in 2018, the film stars Mark Wahlberg (as Pete) and Rose Byrnes (plays Elle) as the parents who adopt three siblings as they learn the ropes of instant parenting. After expressing interest in a 15-year old girl (Lizzie), they meet at an Adoption Fair, Pete and Elle learn of her two other siblings (Juan and Lita) and end up navigating the many challenges and unpredictability encountered by the new parent adoptive role with three children at once.

In the film, during a foster care orientation, a case worker named Karen, played by Octavia Spencer, states that there are over half a million children in foster care in an

overloaded system. The reality of older kids in their teen years aging out of the system is also emphasized by a woman formerly in the foster care system. She states *over half the kids that age out of foster care end up homeless, incarcerated, addicted, or deceased within 2 years*. Prior to the adoption, Pete and Elle attend an 8-week foster care parenting class to earn a certification, and they join a foster care support group with other adoptive parents to share the complexities of parenting foster kids. Often, the foster children can act out due to rejection, instability, betrayal, and mistrust. Another reality they contend with in the film is the presence of the biological mother who, for a short time, expresses a desire to remain sober and care for the siblings permanently during a court hearing, but then doesn't follow through. It's emphasized that in the system, up until the kids are adopted, the primary goal is family preservation. However, this isn't always feasible. *Instant Family* follows prospective adoption parents through a

realistic experience of the California foster and adoption system, through their certification, matching process, and placement.

Foster Children in School

Foster children, like all other children, go to school. Some states allow them to go to public school, private school, or are homeschooled, while some states don't allow homeschooling. If foster parents can provide financial assistance to send a child to a private school, they can otherwise opt for public school or homeschooling, depending on the laws. Foster children are not distinguished in school; other children may not even know their schoolmates are foster kids. They look like a normal family in the eyes of everyone in school. It is not ethical to ask a foster child about what led them in foster care, like rekindling a hurtful past of an individual. Foster children being treated as a normal child in school keeps these situations at par. If a child wants to go to a school they used to attend before ending up in foster care, in the best interest

of the child, they can attend the same school. If it is not in their best interest, they will have to move to a school zone in the foster parents area. If a child can't stay focused in school due to the trauma they went through before entering foster care, being taken off from their family, or due to any disabilities, they may qualify for IEP (Individualized Education Program).


These disabilities include:

- Autism
- Cognitive disabilities
- Hearing impairment
- Emotional behavioral disabilities
- Speech and language impairment
- Other health impairment
- Orthopedic impairment

- Significant developmental delay
- Specific learning disabilities
- Traumatic brain injury
- Visual impairment

Some children may even require physical or occupational rehabilitation to meet their educational goals. Schools develop an IEP based on an evaluation on the child. School nurses, teachers, guidance counselors, special education directors, social workers, administrators, school psychologists, and foster parents (after biological parents sign off – if applicable) are included in developing the IEP. IEP is eligible for kids from 3 to 21 years.

Statistics say only 3% of foster kids end up in college. There are various sponsorships and financial assistance provided for them to enter college.

HOW DOES A PILOT KNOW WHICH WAY TO GO IN THE SKY?

Ever wondered how pilots find directions in the sky? Do they just take off at the starting place and land at the destination? Jump into the facts to know the answer.

Just like GPS that shows us the path while driving or walking, there is a navigation system in the sky. The hidden location markers around the earth also known as waypoints shows the pilot which way to go, what's the next checkpoint, entry point to a country, and exit point of a country.

A waypoint is used to indicate a change in direction, speed, or altitude along the journey. Most of the waypoints are not real places on the ground. These are like imaginary and virtual landmarks in the sky. The navigation system on the cockpit provides a trail for the pilot to follow and eventually, it gets registered in the pilot's memory. Normally, waypoints are placed 20-40 miles apart. Stay tuned for the next interesting motor fact in the next issue.
